11.2 Essex Police Service Board Amalgamation

Chair Councillor Verbeek explains to the members that the Essex County Police Service Board at the direction of the Solicitor General in 2019 retained a third party consultation company Foresight Management Consulting in who recommended and advised the board of the benefits of amalgamating the six (6) police service boards within the County of Essex into one.

The County of Essex Police Service Board made a motion to May 13th 2021 meeting to have a two-board system. With the boards being divided between the Municipalities of Tecumseh and Lakeshore, and the Municipalities of Kingsville, Learnington, Peele, and Caldwell Nations.

She stated that the decision of the County of Essex Board is being presented to the Solicitor General by June 7th 2021.

She advised that the Essex Police Service Board needs to decide on which of the two boards proposed would Essex like to sit on.

Katie McGuire Blais advised that she can see the pros and cons of both boards. Tecumseh and Lakeshore is like the Town of Essex, however with Kingsville and Leamington being neighbours it seems more logical she stated. But has concerns with the capacity of services Leamington requires and stated that Essex may get lost during the meetings.

Richard Tapping concurred with Katie McGuire Blais

Karen Robertson stated that Leamington's Mayor Hilda Macdonald advised that they would not be renewing the O.P.P contract and would therefor make the proposed board smaller in nature and a better fit for Essex.

Chair Verbeek advised that the decision to not renew the contact would be up to the Municipalities Council members. She advised that a meeting is to transpire in the near future to determine if the O.P.P contract will be renewed.



HOW TO SUBMIT THE NOMINATION FORM ONLINE

Please note that **nomination forms can only be submitted online if you use the "online form" version.** To select the correct version, click on the "online form" option on the PDF and follow the steps in the <u>How to Complete an Online Nomination</u> section.



Purpose

The Lieutenant Governor's Community Volunteer Award for Students pays tribute to students who not only complete the required number of volunteer hours to graduate, but who go above and beyond.

Each year, an award is given to one graduating student at each of Ontario's secondary schools.

Who is eligible?

The award is for students who are graduating from an Ontario high school (public, provincial, private and demonstration).

How are the recipients selected?

School principals, or their designate, select one student from their school and complete and submit the recipient submission form.

A school committee dedicated to student recognition may also select the recipient. However, only the principal and/or his or her designate may complete and submit the form.

How do I make a submission?

Each submission must include the following:

- A completed and signed submission form *
- Confirmation that the student is a graduating student selected for this award by their school principal or an awards selection committee for exemplary community contribution or outstanding achievement through volunteer activity. *
- Confirmation that the submission is made by the student's principal or his or her designate. *




