Recommendation(s)

That Community Services-2022-12 entitled Special Event Notice – Harrow Chamber Open Streets – June 24, 2022 prepared by Jake Morassut, Director, Community Services, dated June 20, 2022 be received, and

That Council approve waiving Noise By-Law #2038 from 4:00 PM to 8:00 PM on Friday June 24, 2022 to accommodate the entertainment for the Harrow Chamber Open Streets event; and

That Council approve closing King Street between 44 King Street (OPP Station) and Erie Street, with Queen Street to McAffee throughway remaining open, between 4:00 PM and 8:00 PM for the Harrow Chamber Open Streets.

Purpose

To obtain Council approval for waiver of the Town of Essex Noise By-Law #2038, and to receive Council approval for a road closure during the Harrow Chamber Open Streets on June 24, 2022 from 4:00 PM to 8:00 PM.

Background and Discussion

Town Administration and the Special Events Resource Team (SERT) have reviewed the event and have no objection to any of the activities and recommend that Noise By-Law #2038 be waived in the Downtown Area of Harrow to accommodate the entertainment for the Harrow Chamber Open Streets from 4:00 PM to 8:00 PM on June 24, 2022.

The Special Event Resource Team also concurred with closing King Street between Erie Street and 44 King Street (Harrow OPP Station), while leaving the throughway from Queen Street to McAffee Street open, in Harrow between 4:00 PM and 8:00 PM.
