The Corporation of the Town of Essex

By-Law Number 2166

Being a by-law to enter into an Agreement between GFL Environmental Inc. and The Corporation of the Town of Essex for garbage and refuse collection

Whereas Section 11 of The Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 authorizes a municipality to pass by-laws for the provision of waste management;

And whereas the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Essex is desirous of entering into a contract for the collection, removal and disposal of waste and organics within the corporate limits of the Town of Essex;

And whereas the Town of Essex requires the services of a contractor for the collection and disposal of all waste and organics;

And whereas, under Section 5 of The Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, the powers of a municipality shall be exercised by its Council, by by-law;

And whereas the Town of Essex passed By-Law Number 1403 on August 10, 2015, entering into a 3-year agreement with an extension for an additional two years (to March 21, 2020) and a further extension to December 31, 2021. Since that time the existing contract has continued on a month-to-month basis with Windsor Disposal Services LTD (now owner by GFL Environmental Inc.) for the collection, removal and disposal of waste and organics within its corporate limits;

And whereas the Council of the Town of Essex desires to enter into an Agreement with Windsor Disposal Services from June 1, 2022 until May 31, 2024;

Now therefore be it resolved that the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Essex enacts as follows:

- 1. That the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the said Agreement on between The Corporation of the Town of Essex and Windsor Disposal Services Limited, a copy of which is attached as Schedule "A" to this by-law.
- 2. That By-Law Number 1403 is hereby repealed.
