
Purpose

To obtain Council approval for a temporary noise exemption under Noise By-Law #2038, and to receive Council approval for a road closure during the Harrow Soap Box Derby on June 22, 2024, (Rain Date June 23, 2024) from 7:30 AM to 4:30 PM.

Background and Discussion

Town Administration and the Special Events Resource Team (SERT) have reviewed the event and have no objection to any of the activities and recommend that a temporary noise exemption be given under Noise By-Law #2038 in the Downtown Area of Harrow to accommodate the entertainment and announcing for the Harrow Soap Box Derby from 7:30 AM to 4:30 PM on June 22, 2024 (Rain Date June 23, 2024) and

The Special Event Resource Team also concurred with closing King Street between Erie Street and Queen Street, and between Victoria Street North from King Street to 18 Victoria Street North from 7:30 AM and 4:30 PM for the Harrow Soap Box Derby.
