
### Purpose

## Background and Discussion

The Special Event Resource Team reviewed and concurred with closing Walker Road from the 11<sup>th</sup> Concession to Parkside Drive, and Concession 11 from Walker Road to 11081 11<sup>th</sup> Concession between 8:45 AM and 10:00 AM for the Steam and Gas Engine Parade.

Administration notified the Town of Amherstburg of the event and the Town of Essex and Town of Amherstburg are working to determine the policing requirements for the event. The Organizers have been notified that policing will be required this year, and in future years, on Walker Road.
