
Purpose

To obtain Council approval for a temporary noise exemption under Noise By-Law #2038, and to receive Council approval for a road closure during the Essex Soap Box Derby on August 17, 2024, (Rain Date August 18, 2024) from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM.

Background and Discussion

Town Administration and the Special Events Resource Team (SERT) have reviewed the event and have no objection to any of the activities and recommend that a temporary noise exemption be given under Noise By-Law #2038 in the Downtown Area of Essex Centre to accommodate the entertainment and announcing for the Essex Soap Box Derby from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM on August 17, 2024 (Rain Date August 18, 2024) and

The Special Event Resource Team also concurred with closing Talbot Street North between Victoria Street and Laird Avenue, and Wilson Avenue between Talbot Street North and 15 Wilson Avenue from 8:00 AM and 4:00 PM for the Essex Soap Box Derby.
