That Council approve closing Walker Road in McGregor between 8:45 AM and 10:00 AM for the Essex County Steam and Gas Engine Museum Annual Parade.

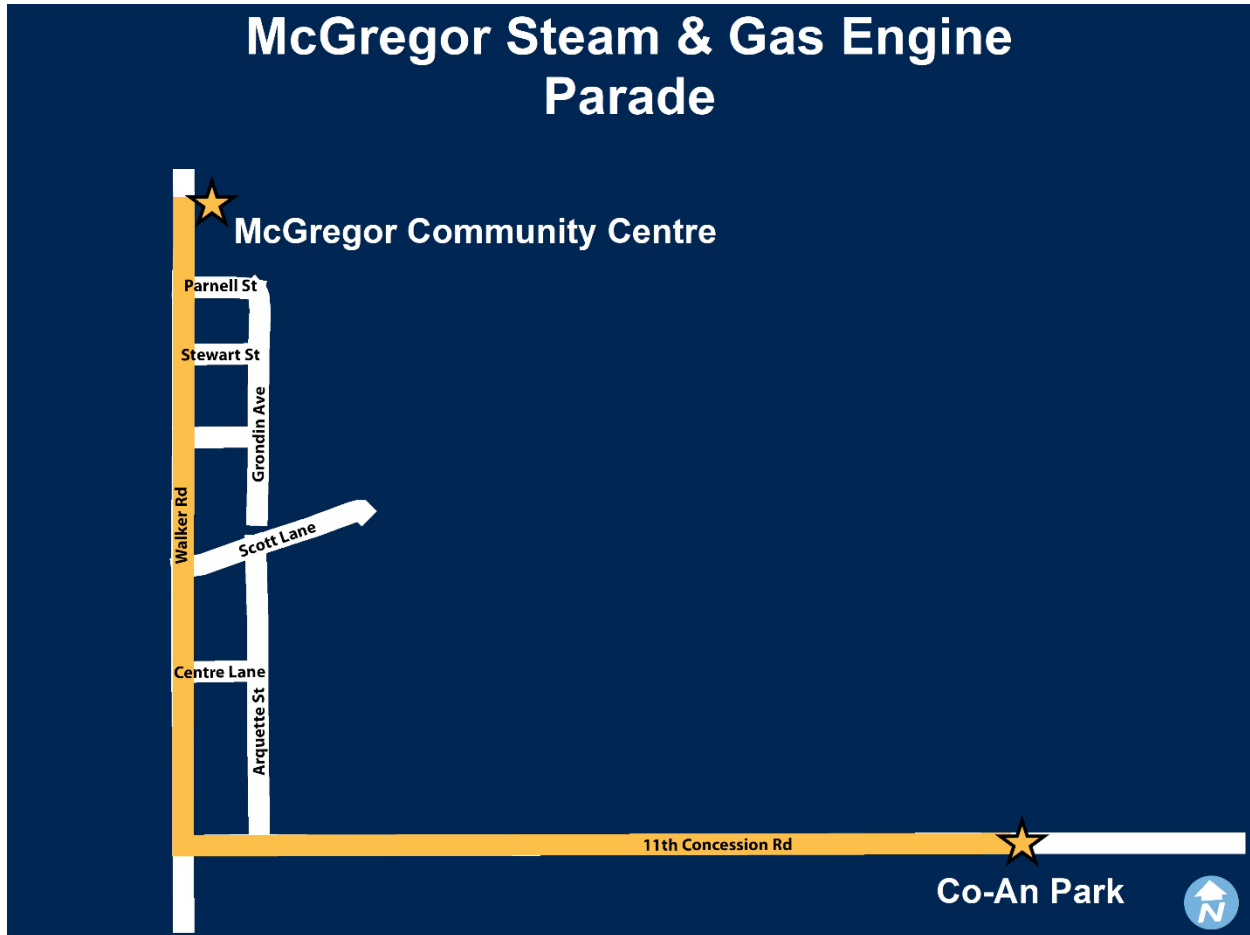
Purpose
