I am the lawyer to The Roman Catholic Episcopal Corporation of the Diocese of London in Ontario, the legal owner to the subject property. Your letter dated June 24, 2024 to the Diocese but addressed to a local address came to the attention of the Diocese recently. The corporate office of the Diocese is in London, Ontario. The Diocese is asking for an extension of time from July 27, 2024 to September 16, 2024 to respond and serve a Notice of Objection.

As you can hopefully appreciate such a designation may have a significant impact on the parish and it is quite concerned. The Diocese is currently unable to consult with its usual Planning Consultant since he is away on vacation. The Diocese needs time meet with the Planner, and after receiving his advice, to then meet with the parish priest and others within the parish community to relay information to them and receive their input.

My practice area does not include the Heritage Act jurisprudence, and the Diocese may need to also consult with a lawyer who practices in this area of law depending upon the position of the Planner and the parish. I trust you can appreciate that all of this will take at least several weeks for the Diocese to submit an informed response.
