
Essex Optimist Recreation Soccer League (EORSL)



Number of Participants the last 3 years.

- We have clearly increased from 400 in 2022 to 590 in 2024.
- We want to offer to as many families as possible
- Approx. we would have over 300 families at the fields on Saturdays which would not only include the participants but also their parents, aunts, uncles, grandparents and more.



Other Participants at the Fields

- Over 30 Adult league has approx. 100 participants
- Essex Sun County Travel teams has 130 participants
- Essex Optimist Soccer League (house league) employs approx. 50 refs which get paid more then minimum wage. Most are teenagers ranging from 10 years old to 18 years old.
- Essex Travel Soccer employs approx. 25 refs. Again making over minimum wage and mostly teenagers.
- ▶ We had a new program this year that offered soccer skills to 3 year olds. We ended up with 40 participants and we had to close registration. For \$20 they got a shirt, ball, medal and 6 weeks of skills.

Affordable Sport for Families

Future Soccer Fields and Baseball Diamonds

- We can offer more house league opportunities to more participants as we have to cap our registration each year due to lack of fields.
- We can host tournaments for Sun County Travel. Right now Kingsville and Leamington host a tournament each at their facilities during the year.
- Might be able to start a Club team which is higher soccer league.
- More opportunity for soccer or baseball skill camps.
