By-Law Number 1976

Being a by-law to authorize an Agreement between: Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Ontario as represented by the Minister of Heritage, Sport, Tourism and Culture Industries (the "Province")

-and-

The Corporation of the Town of Essex (the "Recipient")

Whereas, Section 11(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 and amendments thereto, provides that a Municipality may provide any service or thing that the municipality considers necessary or desirable for the public;

And Whereas the Town as Recipient has applied for funding under the Tourism Economic Development and Recovery Fund to develop an Agri-Tourism Strategy for the Town of Essex as further defined in the Agreement (the "Project").

And Whereas the Province wishes to provide funds to assist with the Project, in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Transfer Payment Agreement (the "Agreement") attached hereto as Schedule "A" to this By-Law Number 1976.

Now therefore be it resolved that the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Essex enacts as follows:

- That the Mayor and Clerk be authorized to sign the Agreement attached as Schedule "A" to this By-Law 1976.
- 2. That the Mayor and Clerk be hereby authorized to sign such further documents and give such further assurances as may be necessary to give effect to this By-law.
- 3. That this by-law shall come into full force upon the final passing thereof.
