Swift Watch 2025

Our swift watch events were very well attended by both humans and birds!

Below is the tally of swifts we recorded during the annual count at the schoolhouse. These counts happen simultaneously across Ontario on the same nights to ensure that we are not counting the same birds.

May 17 - 108, May 21 - 126, May 25 - 66, May 29 - 50, June 2 - 41

This was a very successful count! We invite you to join us next Spring for the 2026 Swiftcount. All this data is sent to Birds Ontario for an official count. To see the results for the province go to www.birdscanada.org
