

The Corporation of the Town of Essex

By-Law Number 2109

Being a by-law to enter into a Contribution Agreement between The Economic Developers Council of Ontario through Her Majesty The Queen in Right of Canada (“Her Majesty”) as represented by the Minister (the “Minister”) responsible for Federal Economic Development Agency for Southern Ontario and The Corporation of the Town of Essex (“The Participant”)

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Contribution is to support businesses and stimulate economic activity in the Participant’s Main Street communities by way of a Main Street Ambassador and delivery of a Main Street Accelerator Program.

WHEREAS, funding for activities performed under this Contribution are provided by EDCO, through an initiative of Her Majesty The Queen In Right Of Canada (“Her Majesty”) represented by the Minister (the “Minister”) responsible for Federal Economic Development Agency for Southern Ontario.

WHEREAS, as part of the Southern Ontario Prosperity Program, the Minister has approved this project designed to support businesses and stimulate economic activity in communities across Southern Ontario.

WHEREAS, The Town of Essex has submitted a Main Street Local Business Accelerator Application proposal and has been accepted by EDCO including the retention of a Main Street Ambassador, as identified in the Contribution Agreement.

Now therefore be it resolved that the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Essex enacts as follows:

1. That the Agreement between the Corporation of the Town of Essex and The Economic Development Council of Ontario, through an initiative of Her Majesty The Queen In Right Of Canada (“Her Majesty”) represented by the Minister (the “Minister”) attached hereto and marked as Schedule “A” be approved accordingly;
2. That the Mayor and the Clerk be hereby authorized to sign the said Agreement on behalf of The Corporation of the Town of Essex; and
3. That this By-Law shall come into full force upon the final passing thereof.

Read a first, a second time and a third time and finally passed on December 20, 2021.
