Rita, I have over fifty places ,[homes, cemeteries, Wright' landing, Snyder's landing; Salmoni's dock] documented .The oldest home was built in 1806/07 at Chestnut Grove near Oxford, Oxley. I would like to have the 220 plus year old road from County Rd.41 to County Rd.23 designated a heritage road to preserve it's historical and heritage value. This could be promoted by the Heritage committee and the town as an area for historians and tourists to visit. Several homes near the winery are all over 175 years old and the winery is part of an original 200 acre grant. Any signage on the road should enhance the history of the road and be appropriate to the area. I would be willing to work with the committee and council through HEIRS in the promotion of the road as a place to visit. The picture of the sign in question in the Harrow Hews in my opinion is not appropriate for the road and the nearby historical homes.
