The Corporation of the Town of Essex By-Law Number 1924 Being a By-Law to: Delegate the Duties and Powers of the Council of the Town of Essex

Whereas pursuant to Section 23.1 of the Municipal Act, 2001 and the amendments thereto a municipality may delegate its powers and duties to a person or body subject certain restrictions;

And whereas on December 7, 2007, Council adopted By-Law Number 869, being a by-law to adopt the Delegation of Powers and Duties Policy pursuant to Section 270(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001 and amendments thereto;

And whereas on April 7, 2015, Council adopted By-Law Number 1404, being a by-law to delegate the Duties and Powers of Council of the Town of Essex pursuant to Section 270(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001 and amendments thereto;

And whereas on August 20, 2018, Council adopted By-Law Number 1737, being a by-law to amend By-Law Number 1404 being a by-law to delegate the duties and Powers of Council of the Town of Essex pursuant to Section 270(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001 and amendments thereto;

And whereas the Council of the Town of Essex now deems it desirable to amend and further delegate certain of its powers and duties in order to support the efficient management of municipal operations as set out in Schedule "A" to this By-Law;

And whereas any noted restrictions as to the authority delegated and communication requirements, if applicable, are identified in Schedule "A" to this By-Law;

Now therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Essex hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That this By-Law and its Schedule "A' attached thereto shall come into force and take effect on the day of its final passing thereof.
- 2. That By-Laws 869, 1404 and 1737 and all amendments hereto are hereby repealed.

Read a first, a second, and a third time and finally adopted on July 20, 2020.
