Currently, Tim is a member of the Board of Directors of the United Way of Windsor & Essex County, is a member of the Governance and Development Committee, and Chairs the Compensation Sub-Committee. Tim has been a member of United Way's Equity & Diversity, Data Governance, Social Enterprise and Strategic Planning Committees and Chaired the Community Impact Council. During 2015-16 Tim served as Chair of the annual United Way Campaign.

Tim represents United Way on the Executive Leadership Council of ProsperUs, a collaborative of private, public and not-for-profit organizations developing a strategy and programming to eliminate Childhood Poverty in Windsor and Essex County. Tim is Co-Chair of the ProsperUs Investors Table.

In September 2022 Tim joined the Board of Directors for the Canadian Mental Health Association (Windsor-Essex County Branch) and is currently Vice-Chair of the Board and a member of the Governance and Nominating Committee.

Since September 2023 Tim has been a member of Hotel Dieu Grace Healthcare's Finance and Audit Committee. From June 2013 to June 2017 Tim had served as a member of the Board of Directors for HDGH, including as Vice Chair, was Chair of the Governance Committee and was a member of the Quality and Patient Care and Workplace Excellence Committees. Tim was also Chair of the Board of Directors of HDGH's Changing Lives Together Foundation.

Tim was active in his service to the community even before retirement serving as a Board Member of the Teen Health Centre, Windsor Essex Community Health Centre, and Brain Injury Association of Windsor & Essex County.

As a retiree Tim is fortunate to have many options about how to spend his time and energy. True to his values he remains committed to doing what he can to make our community a better, more compassionate and equitable place to live for everyone.
