Background

The members of the Dog Pound Committee are provided with an overview of the intake and disposition of each dog throughout the calendar year. These statistics are then used to determine the percentage of the yearly budget paid by each of the four municipalities, based on the use of the facility (also known as "dog days").

Please note that the following analysis is based on the statistics to date and is provided for information only.

Comments

In 2023, the number of dogs (143) admitted to the Dog Pound is significantly higher than the previous year.

The breakdown of the 2023 use of the facility is as follows:



Recommendation

Approve the 2024 Dog Pound Budget as presented April 16, 2024.

Background

The 2024 budget for the Dog Pound is being presented to the Committee for review and approval. Year-to-date expenses for 2023 have been included up to December 31, 2023.

Comments

Operating Costs

The recommended budget for operating costs is based on historical costs for the operation of the Dog Pound, as well as anticipated increases.

Utility costs have increased slightly and have been broken out into separate accounts in order to better track expenses throughout the year.

The 2024 draft budget provides for \$107,170 in operating expenses.

Revenue

The estimated revenue has been included at the 2024 budget rate of \$2,500.

Financial Impacts

The 2024 Draft Budget includes net operating costs of \$107,170 representing an increase of 9% from the 2023 budget.
